
We enjoy having parents visit BASEBALL WORLD and we encourage you to support your youngster. In order for us to achieve our instructional goals, we must ask you to kindly adhere to the

**PARENT'S CODE**, as follows:

- 1. NON-FRATERNIZATION** with your youngster during the games and practices, we need the player's full attention. Standing next to the dugouts during games or practices will not be permitted. Benches are provided for your seating comfort.
- 2. NO NEGATIVE COMMENTS** towards any youngsters. This includes yelling, screaming or **attempting** to "**coach**" your child from sidelines.
- 3. NON-INTERFERENCE IN THE COACHING PROCESS.** If you have a complaint, **please see Coach Red Berry**. We have found too many voices will impede a youngster's concentration. The coaches voices are the only voices we want to youngster to hear.
- 4. NO YELLING OR DEROGATORY COMMENTS** to our umpires. They are human and just like big league umps miss some calls, so will we!
- 5. POSITIVE CHEERING FOR THE TEAMS IS PERMITTED!**

The above five points will be **strictly enforced**.
